APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR RECOGNITION AS AN ASEAN CHARTERED PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER BY REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS IN PRESCRIBED BRANCHES OF ENGINEERING

- A professional engineer registered with PEB with a valid practicing certificate (PC) in the branches of chemical, civil, mechanical or electrical engineering, who meets the following requirements is eligible to apply for recognition as an ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineer (ACPE) and have his name placed on the ASEAN Chartered Professional Engineers Register:
 - a) has citizenship of a ASEAN member country,
 - b) completed an accredited or recognised engineering programme,
 - c) been assessed as eligible for independent practice,
 - d) has a minimum of seven years of practical experience since graduation,
 - e) complies with the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) policy at a satisfactory level, and
 - f) agrees to be bound by code of professional conduct and ethics.
 - g) has obtained a PC over a period of at least 2 years
- A **professional engineer with a valid PC** applying for recognition as ACPE is deemed to have met all the conditions above subject to confirmation of items a), d) and e). An applicant would be required to submit details of practical experience (Item d above) where applicable and details of significant engineering work he was in responsible charge of (Item e above) to demonstrate that he has meet the requirements in Item d) and Item e) above.
- In respect of Item e), a professional engineer may be taken to have been in responsible charge of significant engineering work when he has:
 - a) planned, designed, coordinated and executed a small project;
 - b) undertaken part of a larger project based on an understanding of the whole project;
 - c) undertaken novel, complex and/or multi-disciplinary work.
- 4 Application for recognition as ACPE must be submitted on the prescribed forms with the prescribed fees. The application must be legibly written in ink or type-written and submitted with a recent passport size photograph.
- Application must be accompanied by Annex A- Selection Of Practical Experience After Graduation where applicable and Annex B Selection Of Significant Engineering Work In Responsible Charge.
