THE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS  
(APPROVED QUALIFICATIONS) (AMENDMENT)  
NOTIFICATION 1992.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 (1) (b) of the Professional Engineers Act, the Minister for National Development, after consultation with the Professional Engineers Board, hereby makes the following Notification:

1. This Notification may be cited as the Professional Engineers (Approved Qualifications) (Amendment) Notification 1992 and shall come into operation on 8th May 1992.

2. The Schedule to the Professional Engineers (Approved Qualifications) Notification is amended by inserting, at the end of Part 1, the following entries in the appropriate columns as shown hereunder: <sup>N 1.</sup>
